Number 2601:

START PROCEDURE CLARIFIED: YOU CANNOT OVERTAKE AFTER RED LINE UNTIL THE START LIGHT IS GIVEN.

TIME PENALTIES FOR FALSE STARTS INCLUDING OVERTAKING AFTER THE RED LINE IN THE FORMATION LAP, CROSSING THE CORRIDOR LINES DURING THE START PROCEDURE AND BEING IN AN IRREGULAR POSITION ON THE STARTING GRID WILL BE AUTOMATICALLY IMPOSED BY THE COCON THE DRIVER CONCERNED WITHOUT A HEARING.

PENALTY IS 3 SECONDS HAVING 2 WHEELS OUTSIDE THE CORRIDOR LINE AND 5 SECONDS FOR 4 WHEELS OUTSIDE THE CORRIDOR LINES.

Number 2602:

Each event in 2026 will consist of: 2 qualifying sessions. heat 1 & heat 2 and final. All classes will run to this format. All drivers must do qualifying 1 and 2.

Number 2603:

Races will be run on time rather than number of laps.

Number 2604:

We intend to run events to a predesigned timetable.

Number 2605:

Scrutiny Safety Checks: You are required to present your kart and equipment for full scrutiny and scanning on Saturday after you have check in, it is the responsibility of each driver to complete their scrutiny. All karts must pass this check before they are allowed compete.

Safety Equipment

1: Helmet complies with regulations for Karting. Child helmet required for 15 years and under. Visor must be for the helmet.

2: Race suit for kart use only. Must be on the FIA Kart technical list. No rips or tears.

3: Race gloves in good order.

4: Race boots in good order.

5: Rib protector.

6: Neck brace for MINI & Bambino

7: Numbers correct and legible.

8: Race tyres slicks & wets.

Check In:

Ensure you complete the required sign on / indemnity form online using the INEO system.

- Driver check in will take place in the Clubhouse on Saturday from 3.00pm until 5.30pm and it is mandatory for all drivers /entrants.
- Please bring the following items with you: Valid competition kart licence of appropriate grade.
- Valid minor entrant license for drivers under the age of 18. **If the holder of the Minor Entrant Licence is not the parent / legal guardian of the minor then a duly completed Minor Entrant nomination form must be presented at licence check (available at <https://motorsportireland.com/Public/Public/Competitors/Competitor-forms.aspx>**
- Transponder number

Any competitor who is unable to attend Saturday check in/scrutiny must notify the event secretary by email to munsterkartclubsec@gmail.com no later than 5pm on Saturday, 21st March to make alternative arrangements. Anyone who does not complete the check in process will not be permitted to race on Sunday.
